

## 03-16-14rb-ax **Joy Is The Demonstration God's Love**

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The following text was transcribed from Paul Ray Huffman's digital voice recording, March 16, 2014, approximately 2:00 PM, Sedona, Arizona, on a beautiful spring like day.

*Summary: Joy is the demonstration of God's love. The purpose of life is to demonstrate God's love. Your only success in life is to demonstrate God's love. Your joy is God's joy and God's joy is your joy. Your desire to see your Self is God's desire to see Him Self. You have never done anything wrong because you are always seeking to express God's love for Him Self.*

“Show Me the love that I Am, Paul. Demonstrate to Me, through words and actions, the love that I Am.” Fear nothing. Love everything. Accept your life as it is now. Accept and receive your body as it is now. Accept and receive your life and the circumstances around your life as it is now. Resist no thing. Resist no feeling, or thought, or circumstance. Judge no thing, or feeling, or circumstance in your life. Notice everything. Be aware of everything. Observe everything. Focus your attention on the description of love.

What is love? What does it look like? How is it demonstrated? How do you, Paul, show God the love that He is? How do you show your Self the love that you are? What is the best use of your time? What is your focus? How do you remain present this moment, now? What is your daily practice? What is your hourly practice? What is your moment-to-moment practice? Are you showing God the love that He is at this moment, now? Are you surrendering to God this moment

now? Are you the Awareness of God this moment, now? Is God feeling, and seeing, and speaking through you now? What is the nature of God? What are the characteristics of God? What is Paul's particular purpose, and demonstration towards God in order to show God the love that He is? In other words, how does Paul show God the love that He is? What does that look like? How is that displayed or demonstrated? What can this body do to show God the love that He is? How can Paul's mind assist the body in demonstrating love towards God, and love towards the body, and the self of Paul, and love towards mankind, and the environment of this world? How does Paul focus his attention on the demonstration of love to all that God is? (10:54)

There is nothing that you must be in order to do (demonstrate) the love of God. There is nothing that you must do in order to demonstrate the love of God. If you simply sit here quietly in the Stillness of your mind, God experiences your breath and your body. If you open your eyes God sees, through your presence, through your eyes, the beauty of His world, the beauty of His inner Self. He sees the love that He is. Breathing and being alive is enough. You can feel God's joy Paul, by just sitting and breathing. Nothing more is required of you, but there is joy is there not, in communicating with God, with communicating and even reaching into the highest awareness That you are. (14:38)

The joy of God is His seeing, and feeling, and knowing, and experiencing the love that He is. Your joy Paul, your profound and deep joy, and satisfaction is seeing and feeling and experiencing the love that you are. Your joy Paul is not separate, or different in any way from the joy of God. If you desire deep and

profound happiness, and joy, and being-ness, and presence, it is because God desires to see the love that He is. Your desire to see your Self is God's desire to see Him Self. God asks the question, “Who and What am I? Show Me who I Am. Demonstrate to Me who I Am.” And thus, you as a Self, ask the question, “Who and what am I? I desire to see my Self. I desire to know my Self. I desire to know who and what I am.” It is the same question. It is the same Being asking the question, and it is the same Self asking a question. The Self of Paul is in fact the Self of God. (19:20)

You Paul, as a personality ego-mind, may believe this statement to be untrue or impossible, but the Self of God is displayed, promoted, demonstrated, within every self, and within every thing. The Self of God are the stars at night, or (and) your planet at night as it revolves around your central sun. Every thing and every self and every point of consciousness, awareness, exists to show God the love that He is. There is no thing, or self out of place in the universe, or within consciousness, or within the demonstration of consciousness. There is nothing foreign, or unnatural within God's world. You are not an accident Paul. The (a) single blade of grass upon the lawn of someone's house is not an accident. It has a purpose, it has a consciousness, and it has a focus of being a blade of grass upon this beautiful lawn. There is not one star that is out of place within the universe. There is not one emotion, or one feeling within your body Paul, that is out of place within the universe. Everything before you, every thing before you Paul, demonstrates the love that you are, and the consciousness that you are, and the love of God. (25:05) You cannot possibly do anything wrong within your

demonstration of the love of God. You cannot live your life wrongly. You cannot live your life as a mistake. You cannot waste your time. You cannot waste somebody else's time, and you cannot live of a bad life, or an unproductive life. Every breath is productive. Every movement of your body is perfect, and belongs perfectly within the movement of the universe. You have never done anything wrong, and you never will do anything wrong, for if you could possibly do something wrong, it would imply that God can do something wrong, or that it is possible for God to make a mistake. God cannot be other than love. There is no other possibility. God cannot be other than perfect in His movements, or His movement. If you simply open your eyes and open your awareness, open your feelings, open your mind, open your body, you will see the perfection of God, and the universe, and your self. You will see that there is nothing to do, nor be other than the demonstration of God's love, other than demonstrating God's love back to God. Your joy Paul is in demonstrating and speaking to God about His love, and His perfection. And His joy is seeing and feeling the love that He is. His joy is in the movement of Himself, (and) is in the display of Himself. (30:05)

Think of some of the most wonderful movies you have seen upon this earth. Remember how much fun it was to be involved and to experience the movie, and you will have an understanding of how God feels as He watches Him Self move within the projection of Him Self, (in) what you would call the demonstration of Creation. (31:35)

If you seek the joy of who you are Paul, seek the joy of God, seek the Mind of God, seek the awareness of God this moment, seek God's presence, seek God's Stillness, and seek the Stillness that is within you.

God has no future plans for you Paul, nor does He have a past plan for you, nor does He have any regrets of your past, nor does He have any judgment about your past. God does not see your future Paul. God does not know your future, nor does He know His own future, for God is discovering each moment, the love and joy that He is now. Why would God leave this moment now? Why would God leave the joy and the love of this moment now, in order to fantasize about some future event that cannot possibly take place now? God enjoys Him Self now. God enjoys insights and pictures and images as much as you do Paul. As you discover the nature of God, God discovers the nature of Himself. (34:50) As you discover the Truth of God, God discovers the Truth of Himself.

Your ego Paul, desires for you to be successful, but not necessarily happy, or content and deeply satisfied. The pretend self and the pretend mind has no life now, and cannot be held within the arms of God, for the pretend-self ego-mind lives mostly in a fantasy world, a make-believe world, a world of the past and the future which does not exist. It lives in a world of right and wrong, good or bad, successful or unsuccessful, but that world does not exist within the Mind of God, or within Heaven. (37:38)

Insights about God and these words are for you first Paul. It may bring you great joy as you share these words, and you may learn about your self as you share these words. God's joy is [in or] within God's expression of Himself. Your

joy Paul, happiness, is held within your expression of God, and God's love for Him Self. You can express your ego-mind, but it will never be quite the truth, or quite right. By desiring to express God this moment, and desiring to express God this moment, God will move through you, and through your words, through your insights, and through your expression of God. Express God Paul, as you are being held by God. Do not express God as you are being held by your ego-mind. Your ego small-mind does not know of God, and (it) cannot experience God unless it is fully surrendered unto to the Mind of God.

And so it is, on this beautiful day today Paul, on this day of sunshine, and green trees, and blue sky, on this day of warmth and love. End. Bell.
