

01-20-13a PH Chan **Wake Up Now To God's Reality**

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The following text was transcribed from Paul Ray Huffman's digital voice recording, January 20, 2013, approximately 1:00 PM, Sedona, Arizona, on a beautiful warm winter day.

Summary: Being Still, or non-doing, is the doing and the action of life. Being Still and observing life through non-resistance and non-judgment, and the desire for Reality, will lead to an Awakening. No matter what you do or do not do, you cannot hide or be asleep to the Reality of God forever. Waking up is moving from suffering into joy and abundance.

It is January 20, 2013, Paul R. Huffman speaking, approximately 1 PM, Sedona, Arizona, on a beautiful warm winter day. Bell.

Is it not a beautiful day today Paul? The sun is shining and the birds are singing and all is well in your world, a world of great beauty, a world of great harmony, a world that needs nothing to be whom and what it is.

And here you sit once again, wanting to know who and what you are, wanting some answers to the mysteries of life, and the mysteries of God. The peace of God surrounds you Paul, as it always surrounds you.

There is no thing that you must do in order to achieve the peace of God. There is no thing that you must do in order to be surrounded and within the peace of God. There is no place to go. There is no house to clean. There is nothing to buy. There is nothing to fix. There is nothing to accomplish. It is one of

the secrets of life; doing nothing is the doing of life, doing nothing is the action of life. Sitting (being) Still is not only the action of life it is the doing of life. (05:55)

Only by sitting still (non-doing) and observing life, through nonresistance and non-judgment, can you obtain enlightenment, as you call it. Waking up is simply waking up as if you would wake up in the morning and noticed that the room is cold, and that you are warm within your bed. Waking up is similar to waking up in the morning where you are disoriented, and not sure where you are. When you wake up in the morning, you must reconstruct who and what you are. Your mind and your thinking must begin to work and become active, and you will begin to remember your person, and maybe your name, and maybe where you are. You may be happy to wake up, you may be frightened to wake up, but you wake up. You have been a sleep 6, 7, 8, 9, hours, but in time, in time, you wake up. (09:48)

When you have been asleep for many lifetimes, unconscious to God and who you are, there is a moment when you wake up. You cannot sleep forever. You cannot be unconscious forever. You cannot be without God forever. You cannot be without peace and love and God's presence forever.

No matter what you do Paul, no matter your conditions of life, no matter if you have been troubled within life, no matter if you have performed outrageous and murderers acts during your lifetime(s), you will wake up. It is the law. It is the nature of all things and it is the nature within the love of God. No matter what you have done or not done, no matter if you have been religious or not religious, or spiritual or not spiritual, you will wake up. (12:54) You may not want to wake up.

You may resist waking up. You may be unhappy to wake up or frighten to wake up, but you will wake up. You cannot be within the dream forever. You cannot be away from God forever, and you cannot be unhappy and terrified forever. You cannot be in physical, or emotional, or mental pain forever. The nature of God, the nature of Reality, is love and awareness and seeing and observation. You cannot hide or be asleep to the nature of Reality forever. Just as you cannot sleep within your bed forever and dream of fantasies, or dream bizarre (and) unreal dreams. There will come a time when you will wake up, and the room will be warm or cold. You will be deep within the blankets of your bed, and you will wake up unto Reality, and even though it might be unfamiliar, you will wake up unto the joy and the peace and the love of God. (16:58)

And so there is nothing that you must do. There is no place to go. There is nothing to accomplish. It matters not what your neighbor thinks of you, or what your society thinks of you or judges you, or what your self and mind and pretend consciousness thinks or judges who you are. The Reality of God, the peace of God, the love of God, exist now, and it has always surrounded you, and you walk and breathe and live within this Reality. (18:37)

Once you know the Law, once you know that you are surrounded by love and God always, once you know, no matter what you do or say or think, you will wake up. No matter your past, or what you think your future will be, you will wake up. Once you know that your Reality is here and now, and that your Reality is the peace and love of God, you can choose through intention, through relaxation, through focus, to wake up this moment. (In order to wake up this moment,) you

must have no expectations, no judgment, and no resistance. You must let yourself drop [deeply, or] deep within this chair, and let your breath deepen, and let your mind relax, and call to God to wake you from this deep sleep, to wake you from this dream of what love is not and what Reality is not. Through your own efforts, (or) through your own non-effort let's say, your own focus and your own will, your own desire, you will wake up. (23:10)

And when you wake up, the room will be warm or cold, the sun will be shining, or it will be raining. It will be summer or winter, or spring or fall. The angels will be singing or not singing, but you will hear the peace of God. You will feel the love of God. Your bed will be warm, but you will be drawn from your bed into a world of love and peace. At first, you may think that the world has not changed, or the world is no different than it was the night before, but there is a profound change, for you have woken up, and the dream is over. The nightmares are over. The concerns about your life are over. You look at your body in the mirror and you wonder whose body is this? Whose house is this? Whose car is this? Who has all these things within this house? (26:56) And you will ask, Where am I?" And you hear a Voice and the Voice will say, "Paul, you are in heaven and this body belongs to God, and the things within this house, they belong to God, and your (this) house belongs to God." [Or we should say, 'this' house belongs to God, for you own no thing.] You possess nothing, for you are the possession of God. You are now within God's Reality. You are now within God's world. When you wake up, your world may look exactly the same. Your house

may look exactly the same. You have the same friends and neighbors, but now, it all belongs to God. It all belongs to God. (29:50)

So, what are you now, Paul? What moves from room to room? What moves outside, and walks or drives this car? What speaks this language? It is the awareness of God's presence. It is That Which Is Aware. It is That Which Is Awake to what it is. It is God exploring His world, His body, His house, His car, (and) His language. And so what does this person called Paul do? What does this person possessed and owned by God do? The awoken person does nothing on their own. The awoken person has no life of their own, for they are awake unto God. Being awake unto God is the Life of God. Being awake unto God is the Will and the Movement of God. (33:30)

The world may not tolerate an awake being. Society and your neighbor may not tolerate or even care for an awake being. The dream of unreality does not match the dream (reality or desire) of Reality. The dream (reality or desire) of Reality always overwhelms and becomes dominant over unreality. What is Real always supersedes the unreal. What is Real always outlives the unreal. What is Real always wakes up and what is unreal never wakes up, unless it becomes Real. Unreality is not Reality, and therefore it has no power and it does not exist. It can pretend to exist, but that is called a dream, that is called a pretend reality. (36:58)

If you wake up Paul, and your world appears the same, it is not. If you wake up, and your neighbor or your society seems not tolerate who you are, it is certainly not important, and it certainly has nothing to do with you. It is certainly

none of your business. And if you feel that you are being misunderstood, or not recognized as awake, those feelings will pass, for they are remnants of your past dream, and this world of intolerance or judgment will fade.

If you fear waking up Paul, you somehow fear the Reality of God. If you fear waking up because you will be mistreated by your world, you fear the Reality of God's love and peace and tolerance. If you fear waking up, you are still held within the dream of unreality. Fear has nothing to do with the Kingdom of God, nothing. If you fear your body being damaged, or that you will experience pain, you are still held within a dream of unreality. Your body might feel pain, and it might die soon, or never. It is none of your business. It is none of your concern. Your Reality is God's Reality. Your thoughts and consciousness are the thoughts and the consciousness of God. Your Reality is God's Reality. There is no other Reality. You cannot argue with Reality, for you must always argue from a place of unreality. You must always argue from the place of the dream. (43:21)

Waking up, Paul is always reasonable. It is always rational. It is always practical and it is never a sacrifice. Waking up is based on relaxation, on surrender, on letting go, non-resistance, non-judgment, and non-doing. It is based on becoming what you are and leaving behind what you are not. It is based on the practical Realities of God. You are leaving pain and suffering and moving into joy and happiness and abundance. You are leaving the pain of the mind, the worry of the mind, and you are moving into the joy and the peace and the happiness of Mind. You are moving from suffering into joy and that is practical, that is rational, and it is the definition of sanity. (46:50)

And so it is on this beautiful day, this day of sunshine and relaxation. This is God's day, now. Awake unto God's day, Now.

And so it is Paul. Bell. End.
