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Mind Is The Clarity Of God

Summary: You contain all that God Is.

There is nothing outside of your mind and the Mind of God.

Who You Are unfolds in front of you each moment, now.

Everything is happening now, internally.

You are the form, but God is the Mind.

You think that you are doing something,

but you are being carried and breathed by God.

True Mind is seeing clearly What Is. Mind is Joy.

The only purpose of Mind is to tell the story of God.

Mind is the clarity of God and God's purpose.

Your clarity is the Clarity of God.

The joy of who You are is the Clarity of who you are.

Only in thought can you suffer.

To lift your mind out of suffering, give it a job to sing the song of God,

and it will move from darkness into joy, and into God's Mind.

It is January 21, 2012, approximately 4 PM, Paul R. Huffman, speaking, Sedona, Arizona, on a windy cloudy day. It might rain any minute.

Bell. Begin. Is it not a beautiful day today Paul? The sun is trying to shine and the birds are in the trees cautious of this storm. And all is well in your world, a world of great beauty world, a world of great harmony, a world that needs nothing to be who and what it is. And you need nothing Paul, to be who and what you are. The presence of God is within you. The presence of the Holy Spirit and

All That Is, is within you. You contain (and hold) all that God Is. There is nothing that is outside of you. All that you see before you is within you.

This is God's world, as God moves through your body, through your eyes, to see the love that He is. Resist nothing, Paul. Observe everything! Look at the beauty before you. Look at the beauty that you are. Look at the beauty of your friends and your neighbors. See their beauty. See the beauty of God within you. See the generosity of God within you. See the love of God within you. Feel the love of God within you. You are the breath of God. You are the love of God, the joy of God, now. You are the song of God, now. There is no other purpose for you, other than to tell the story of God, other than to sing the song of God. (7:38)

Mind is joy, as these words are joy to you, Paul. True Mind sings the love of God. True Mind sings the love of all things. True Mind gives all of itself, and holds back nothing. True Mind is inspiration. It is the excitement of an idea. It is the solving of a problem. It is seeing clearly What Is. It does not necessarily see the past, or the future, but it does see the Now, which becomes the future (and the past). Your delight in seeing (this moment) also becomes your delight in seeing within the next moment, and the next moment, and the next moment.

When you walk upon this high and suspended cable, and balance each step, each step represents the moment, and even though this cable is a mile-long, you eventually traveled to the end of this cable, one step at a time, one moment at a time. And who you are Paul, is a series of points or steps, that you make each moment. And as you make the step, that which you are unfolds in front of you. It is not that the world unfolds in front of you, or your neighbor, or the

landscape, but it is what you are and who you are, that opens and unfolds. What you see before you each moment, what you feel before you each moment, is that which you are. There is nothing outside of your mind, Paul. Everything is happening, now, internally. There is no tree outside this window, but there is a tree within you, and there is a window within you. It appears to be outside of you, but You are the maker of the tree, and You are the maker of the window. (14:23)

You are held within God. It appears that you look out from your eyes and see the world, but it is God within you looking out, and you are the child of innocence, held within the arms of God. You are the form, but God is the Mind, God is the Intelligence, (and) God is the Love. And you think that you are doing something, but you are being carried, Paul. You are being breathed. You are being lived. And since you can perceive the past and the future, you have formed an idea or thought about who you are.

You look in mirror and you see a body. God looks in the mirror and He sees Himself through you. God looks out from this window and He sees Himself. He sees the joy of His Creation. He feels the joy of His creation. And if you can stop being (and living) who you think you are, you will feel the God within you. You will feel God within you, and Paul will disappear within the ecstasy of what He is. Paul will disappear within the bliss and the love of himself.

God will serve this world through the body (form) of Paul, and Paul will serve this world through the Mind of God. Mind is your inheritance. Mind is the clarity of God and God's purpose. God becomes who He is through His Mind. God sees Himself through His Mind. Your clarity is the clarity of God. Your

insights are the insights of God. The joy of who you are, Paul, is the clarity of who you are. (21:23)

Your happiness lies within knowing and experiencing your Self, and that Self is held within the heart of God. That Self moves and lives within God, as God moves and lives within you. (Clarity is seeing clearly What Is.)

As you move and stretch your hand forward, God moves and stretches His hand forward. As you feel compassion and love for the world, God feels compassion and love for the world. You do not feel separate from God. You do not feel independent from God. You do not see your world separate or independent from God, for this is impossible, and yet your mind says that it is possible. And within that thought there is suffering. Within that separation there is suffering. And yet, how can God cause suffering unto Himself? How would that be possible? (24:19)

Only in thought can you suffer, Paul. There is absolutely no other way that you can suffer. Your body can feel pain for a moment, but that is not suffering. The identity of Self is of God. It is of joy. The identity of Self is not thought, or suffering, or the small body of Paul, or the small thoughts of Paul.

Use your thoughts, Paul. Use your symbols and images to sing the joys and ecstasy of God. Use who you think you are, to sing and to write about God. To lift your mind out of suffering, you must go and find it (mind). You must ask (mind), "Where are you," and give it a job, Paul. Give it a job. Have it paint the most beautiful painting of God. Have it sing the most beautiful song to God, and it will move from the darkness, from the suffering of its self, into the higher levels of joy.

It awaits happiness. It awaits ecstasy. It awaits transformation. It awaits the light of who You are Paul. It is tired of its self, and it is tired of its self, and so it surrenders, and so it surrenders, lost in this make-believe world, lost in its blindness, lost in its unhappiness and fear.

The suffering of your world is so great Paul, and it need not be. The peoples of your world have everything that they need in order to shine, shine, and see the love that they are. When they see the love that they are, they will become the love that they are. As you practice Paul, seeing and hearing the love that you are, you step forward, you step forward another step, towards becoming the love that you are.

And so it is today, a day of beauty and wind, and clouds, and light. What a beautiful day today. And so it is. Bell. End.
