

**The Doorway**

*Summary: Life is on hold. Breath is on hold as you wait to enter this doorway. Practice using your will, your love to come forward Paul, and stand before this doorway and knock and ask to enter the kingdom of heaven. The Door will always open. Practice standing just beyond the threshold and notice how it feels. Allow yourself to be taken in. Allow the love to surround you. Allow the love to move you and feel safe and guided. And so it is Paul.*

It is September 4, 2011, Paul Huffman speaking, Sedona, Arizona. It is approximately 1 PM on a warm partly cloudy day. It might rain this afternoon. Is it not a beautiful day today Paul? The birds are singing the sun is shining and all is well in your world, a world of great beauty and harmony. Your life is just beginning is it not? Once you enter the kingdom of God, your life begins no matter where you are. Whether or not you are sitting here, in this chair, in this room or you are sitting in some other world. No matter what age, no matter how long you have been waiting, but as soon as you enter this doorway, as soon as you enter into this moment of now, and you recognize God as yourself, you begin to live. And so you begin to live a few minutes a day. A few moments here, a few moments they're in which you feel the presence of God. It is like starting and stopping. It is like pushing this button, this pause button, on your recorder. When you're in pause mode, you're waiting to live, you are waiting to speak. You are waiting to hear the sound of God. And so you can travel within your day, within

your time, and you can push the pause button, and then you push it again to start your talk, to begin these words. Your life is of absolutely no importance unless you are speaking to God, unless there is a communication, unless there is a recognition that you both exist. You must believe that God exist. You must believe in the feeling of this present moment. You must believe that you exist only for the purpose of serving God. This is not your life, Paul. This life is not your decision. Your actions, your function, you're doing is the life of God, now. And if you can not feel the presence of God, or hear the voice of God, which is your particular way of communicating, your particular way of entering the kingdom of God, then place yourself on hold. Push the pause button and wait and wait, and wait for this connection. You might say, "I think I'll write a book today," place yourself on hold, or "I think that I will go to the store," or "I will go buy a house, or sell my land," place yourself on hold, Paul, push the pause button.

We are not saying for you to become inactive. We are not saying for you to die, to be no more, but what we are saying is that this is not your life. You have no way of being, or living that is yours. You have no world of your own, no time of your own. You have no projects of your own, no doing of your own. You are the servant Paul. This is in many ways is not a true partnership, for God is the leader, and you are being led. You are God's expression of love, and the smallness of you has no idea what that mean, has no sense of a direction, no sense of doing, no sense of right or wrong, or what is love and what is not love or what is the purpose of God and what is the purpose not of God. Your purpose is held within God's hands and mind and heart. You are the body of God, as the

stars of the body of God. You are the light of God as the sun is the light of God. You are a no thing unless you are a thing of God. You are a non-object unless you are the object of God. Your life is without purpose unless it is the life of God. Your breath is not a breath until it is the breath of God. 16:20

All that we can do is to continue to instruct you. All that we can do is point you in the direction of this doorway. This doorway stands before you now, but you must knock. You must request to enter this doorway. If you knock, the door shall be opened. If you request entrance past this threshold, you will not be denied, but it is up to you Paul, to bring yourself forward with all your strength, intention and will. Move yourself to this doorway and if necessary sit or lay before this great door and rest. And when you are ready, arise and knock firmly on the door. Asked to come into the kingdom Paul, and with your desire and sincerity, the door will open. And since you know not what lies ahead or beyond this doorway, you must trust that you will be safe and taken care of. You must trust that your bills will be paid, or not paid, but it will be okay. You must trust that your words and actions will be, or become, the words of this Kingdom. You must trust that we are on the other side of this threshold as God is on the other side of this threshold. If you cannot enter at this moment or the next moment, or you have not gathered up your will and desire, push the pause button, and breath and wait, and wait until you have calmed yourself, until the smallness has quieted down and fear has left you. (23:24) And then stand and knock firmly on the door, and declare yourself ready to enter. And we will be just beyond this threshold. And as you reach your hand through this doorway, we will hold your hand and we will

guide you gently over this very small threshold. And as you step across not much will happen. It will not feel, at first that anything has changed, but you will feel a little safer, a little more confident and a little happier. You may have to retreat back into your world and then once again, you will return to this doorway and knock and the kingdom of God will be open to you again and again, and again. And as you trust this moment, as you trust love, beauty, kindness and compassion, as you trust our words and the words of God, you will stay longer and longer in this world, and you will gain more and more confidence in being in this other world. But let it be known Paul, that when you return to your world and returned the smallness of your mind, and the smallness of your life, you are on hold. Your life is not happening. Your purpose is not happening and you breathe a shallow breath of indecision, pain and suffering.

Your life is not your life Paul. It is truly the life of God, just as your Earth is the life of God or your Sun is the life of God. The tree outside your window is the life of God. Is it not time for you to begin your life. Is it not time for you to join your body and this tree outside your window, and the sky and the mountains and the oceans. (31:10s) Is it not time to join their life, as their life is already held within the arms of God. Your body has already received the life of God, as this tree outside your window has received and recognizes itself as the life of God. Your purpose is to stand in front of this doorway, as you are doing, and knock and ask for the entrance to God's world. And there will be moments in which you enter, and there will be moments in which you retreat. And so you dance across this threshold.

The more that you commit to standing within this doorway Paul, and stepping across, and stepping across, and taking all that you think you are with you, the faster [that] your life will become, the faster you will wake up and begin your life. If you wish to change time, if you wish to bend and alter time this is how you do it. You stand in front of the (God's) door, you gather your energy together, your desire, your love, your will, and you knock, and the door opens, and with a great breath, you step through the doorway, across the threshold, and you stand within God's kingdom. (36:00) [and] You take a breath. You take a breath. And when you feel safe, you take another step. And when you feel the love of God, you take another step. And soon the doorway will be behind you Paul. You will not think of the retreat. You will not think of stepping backwards and backwards, for now you are suffering less and less, and the joy begins to swell within your heart. You begin to feel the lightness of being. You began to feel held by God, and each moment of your life seems to be guided by the hand of God. (38:18)

Other people in your world may see the change within you and may declare that you are making a mistake, that your life looks like a life of poverty, or it could be great wealth. They could say that you are giving the wrong message, that you have turned the wrong corner within life. But your influence is of God and not necessarily of past friends, or a past world. God declares to you, 'show me the love that I am,' and that love may take many forms, and you may not know the form until the moment that you speak, or the moment that you act. When God declares to you, to demonstrate the love of God, God moves you, and moves you. And that love is demonstrated without effort on your part, without hesitation,

and God feels the love of Himself, and you feel the love of God. And this love is what holds you Paul. This love is what holds you in God's world. (41:59) It is not money, or fame, or even poverty. It is the love of God. It is the sureness of God, because it is the life of God.

And so you practice, do not Paul? Where are you today? Are you just beyond the doorway in God's kingdom? Are you deep within God's kingdom, being held and loved by God. Or, are you in your own world, worrying about your future, breathing shallow breaths of non-existence, non-life, not knowing, suffering with the smallness of your thoughts, suffering with indecision and suffering with not knowing who you are.

And so each moment you can stop Paul, and breathe. You can say, or ask, where am I, what world am I in? Have I surrendered completely to God, now? Am I trying to make decisions about my life or have I surrendered all that I am, all my decisions to God? And so you place your finger on this pause button, as you are doing now, and your life stops. you press the button again and the recorder begins to record. Life is now. These words are now. And so it is on this beautiful day, the life and the presence of God, now. Bell. End.
