

09-07-14ra **Surrender Brings Presence**

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The following text was transcribed from Paul Ray Huffman's digital voice recording (recorder A), September 7, 2014, at approximately 3:30 PM, in Sedona, Arizona, on a cloudy summer day.

Summary:

Surrender brings Presence and Presence reveals the Divine Self. The Divine Self reveals what is true and what is not true. The Divine Self is peace and love and truth. Nothing unreal or untrue can exist within this present moment, this vast space of Now. Fantasy and the pretend selves exist outside of this present moment, Now. They cannot enter because they are not real. They seek love, but they have not found love. They seek the truth, but they have not found the Truth. You exist Paul within this space of Now, this vast unlimited space of Now.

Surrender brings Presence and Presence reveals the love of the Self. Nothing unreal exists and nothing real can be threatened, and therein lies the peace of God. Surrender brings presence and presence brings the peace of God.

And here you sit once again, Paul, wanting answers to who and what you are, wanting relief from your suffering and anxieties, (and) wanting to abide in Presence and love. If you desire to wake up you will wake up. If you desire to be present and awake to who you are it will be so. God desires to see the love that He is. *If you desire to see the love that you are, to know the love that you are, to feel and experience the love that you are it will be so.* If you desire money and things of this world, you shall have them. If you desire the distractions of this

world, you shall be distracted and you shall be of this world. If you desire peace and love and the experience of peace and love, it will be given to you. What you place your focus upon, and give you attention, to will manifest before you. If you desire to be within God's desire and live within God's desire, you shall be taken care of, and all will be given you to fulfill God's desire for Him Self. You have no *self* of your own. You have no *life* of your own. You have no way of being that is your own. There is no life of Paul. There is no *way* of Paul. There is no *movement* of Paul. There are no *personal thoughts* of Paul. There are no *fantasies* of Paul. The personal self, or the pretend self of Paul is over, and the personal self of Paul is over, finished. Paul's personal thoughts and fantasies are finished, completed. Paul, as the personality and object of Paul, the person of Paul is finished, if you so desire that it be finished. Your desire to be at peace with your world, and your neighbor, and this life, creates the opening of God's desire to enter unto you *now*, through the presence of God and the love of God. All else will fall away Paul, all concerns, all aspects of Paul's personality, all dark thoughts and fantasies. All concerns will eventually fall away.

Do you desire this Paul? Do you desire the unknown and the grace of God? Love, grace and beauty and understanding of God are all the same. God's expression through you is love and peace and beauty and joy and surprise. As you discover that you have no life of your own and as you desire to have no life of your own, you enter this great ocean of God's existence, an existence that you have never left, an existence that was veiled unto you, hidden from your view,

hidden from a confused mind, hidden from an unclear mind, (and) hidden from the pretend mind of Paul.

Words will come to you and will be spoken by you, but these are not the words of Paul. Revelations and realizations will come into your field of consciousness, but these are the revelations of God, these are the thoughts and words of God. They may not match any words you have ever heard. They may not agree with the sacred texts of your world. (19:35) These words belong to the presence of God, to the Stillness of God. There will be no “you” to be concerned about. There will be no “Paul” to be worried about his future. If the ego comes forward to claim credit for these words, you will recognize the presence of ego. You will recognize untruth, or what is not true or real. As you know the pretend self can be distracting and depressing, and extremely limiting as you move about this world.

Desire brings willingness and movement into and upon the form of Paul. Paul’s desire to see and to be the beauty and the love of God brings forward the beauty and the love of God within the body of Paul, within Paul’s consciousness. (23:15) The awareness of God becomes the consciousness of Paul, the object, the manifestation of God’s desire to see the love that He is. To sit in meditation, or contemplation, or prayer, or listening is [God] God’s desire to see and to be, (and) to know and to experience the love that He is. God manifests in form, in all form, in order to see the love that He is. God becomes form in order to experience form.

Surrender brings Presence and Presence brings the presence of God into Paul's body and field of existence. Surrender brings Presence and Presence releases the body into love. Surrender brings Presence and Presence brings the awareness of Self. Surrender brings Presence and Presence brings the awareness and love of Self. Surrender brings Presence and Presence brings I Am That I Am. Awareness brings Presence and Presence brings total awareness, total awakening. Surrender brings and reveals Presence and Presence brings and reveals the gifts of God.

Question: Is there any reality to the ego self, or to thought manifestations? Is there anything real around me that I should know about? Are their shadow aspects or pieces of me that weight upon me, that make me feel heavy sometimes?

(Answer:) Focus on surrender and presence and the love of the self and all the unhealed aspects will begin to heal. Psychological manifestations, energies or entities that you have created will eventually dissipate, like a dream dissipates over time or the memory of a dream dissipates over time. You do not need to work on any thing, or to heal any thing your self. The pretend self wants your attention and it wants to be part of your life, but it does not need to be a part of your life any longer, now. (31:57) Allow these aspects to come up, notice them, and allow them to dissipate. Allow fantasies of the mind, ego, to come up and allow them to dissipate. They have no reality within this moment, now. They are not who you are and they have never been who you are. These are shadows pieces and thoughts, energies, entities that you have made throughout your life,

and may or may not have served you. You no longer need them for they do not know *how* to serve you. You might say that you will be building a new aspect, or a new Self for this body and this world, and so you will take parts of the old self, part of the memory, (and) part of the language, and this new Self will serve this present moment, this Presence of God. It will not serve Its Self. It will be here to serve the love of God and the desire of God to see the love that He or It is. This new Self Paul lives within the Now. It is the love of the Now in manifestation. And it works the computer and it drives the car and it goes shopping, but it serves God first. It has no agenda and no life of its own. The love of the Self is always present and always alive now in this moment. The Self is a manifestation of God in form. It lives in God's world as you live now in God's world. You have no life of your own Paul. You have no way of being that is possibly your own.

Surrender brings Presence and Presence brings correction and true perception into your life.

And so it is on this beautiful day, this day of sunshine and presence, and the love of God. End. Bell.
